**ORDER AWARDING ATTORNEY FEE TO LEONARD H. RUBIN, ESQ.
AS ATTORNEY FOR OBJECTOR/INTERVENOR, SANDRA S. RUBIN**

This cause came on for hearing before me, the undersigned one of the Judges of the above-styled Court, on December 1, 2008, on the Sworn Motion for Award of Reasonable Attorney Fees for Leonard H. Rubin, Esq., as Attorney for Objector/Intervenor, Sandra S. Rubin, after due notice, and the Court having taken evidence and heard testimony, and after due deliberation, finds that the legal services of 118.4 hours rendered by Leonard H. Rubin on behalf of Objector/Intervenor, Sandra S. Rubin, enhanced the benefit to the Class, and the fee sought and awarded is less than the percentage of the enhanced benefit to the Class, considering the attorney fees awarded to Class Counsel, and it is now, therefore, ordered and adjudged that Leonard H. Rubin is hereby awarded an attorney fee in the amount of \$ 47,360.00, which the Settlement Administrator is hereby ordered to pay from the common fund of the Class Settlement.
